I have already done this conversion once, fitting a digital decoder. As it lacks sound, I have now made a second version, using an SD05A sound decoder by Doehler and Haass. I fitte dit into the boiler, with a tiny speaker at the front end. In addition I fitted a micro LED for a front light.

The interior and original footplate, with sheet of lead ballast, were fitted into the body from below, so I didn't have to demolish the roof. I forgot about the original coach because I find it ugly as sin....
